Dear art educator:

Thank you for considering entering your students' work in the **Mayfest 2010 Youth Art Show, April 29 through May 2** in Fort Worth's Trinity Park.

Student entries will be judged by a panel of professional artists on composition, effort and overall appeal. Students may submit a **maximum two entries each** in each of the following categories:

- **Drawing (chalk, pencil, pastel, crayon, color pencils)**
- **Painting**
- **Photography/Digital Art**
- **Sculpture/3-D**

Cash prizes will be awarded in four age groups:

- **Pre-school through Second Grade**
- **Intermediate School/Grades 3-5**
- **Middle School and Junior High School/Grades 6-8**
- **High School/Grades 9-12**

Entry Forms

Fill out and return the attached form to list your students and their entries. Make as many copies as you need. E-mail the forms to kristinsul@charter.net or FAX them to **Mayfest headquarters at 817-322-1599** by **Monday, April 19, 2010**.

Labels/Plastic covers

Attach a 3-by-5 note card to the back of flat pieces, such as photos or matted drawings, that displays the **student's name, age, grade and school**. Work may be disqualified if the student's name is visible from the front. For sculpture or other three-dimensional work, list the information above on a note card that can be turned face down and placed next to the piece.

Prepare for rain by protecting your artwork with plastic sleeving or a case. **Mayfest is not responsible for artwork that is lost, stolen or damaged.**

Hanging/displaying the artwork

Hang your students' artwork at the Trinity Park Youth Art Show area **from 8 to 10 a.m. Thursday, April 29**. Call **Kristin Sullivan on cell 817-706-9811** if you have any questions. Park your car at subcommittee parking (from University Drive, turn east and enter the Trinity Park lot from Crestline Drive). Tell the guard that you are delivering artwork and call Kristin if you need help carrying the pieces into the park.

Mayfest will provide grids for hanging artwork. You must **bring your own clips, string, etc. to attach pieces** to the grids. Mayfest cannot provide additional supplies. Student work will be judged Friday and will be available for public viewing Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday afternoon.

Judging/Prizes

Artwork will be judged at **9 a.m. Friday, April 30**. Teachers will be notified by e-mail or cell phone listed on the entry form. Award checks will be made out to the student and may be collected after 3 p.m. Friday in person by the student or teacher.

After the Festival

Artwork must be picked up Sunday, May 2, between 2 to 4 p.m. Call Kristin Sullivan at **817-706-9811** if you have any questions. Students with identification will be allowed to pick up their own work.

We appreciate the hard work you do to make the Mayfest Youth Art Show such a success. We had a tremendous turnout in 2008, and we look forward to being back in the park this year.
